I am a music educator, performer, and UK Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) holder with over fifteen years of international teaching experience across secondary schools, conservatories, and universities in the USA, Asia, and Europe. As a Fulbright Scholar and professional jazz vibraphonist, I bring a combination of academic, pedagogical, and performance expertise to my teaching. My teaching covers jazz, classical and pop music, percussion, piano, drum kit, music theory, harmony, composition, improvisation, and ensemble performance. I am also comfortable supporting students on a range of instruments through both individual and group teaching.

My teaching style is practical, inclusive, and performance-based, with lessons that are engaging, student-centred, and adapted to different abilities. I encourage active participation, creativity, and collaboration while maintaining high expectations in a positive and supportive classroom environment, where every student feels confident to perform, explore, and enjoy music. My international performance and collaboration experience allows me to bring real-world musical insight into the classroom.
